

## Instructional Method & Schedule Type Guide

These are the Schedule Types used at Snow along with their **corresponding** Instructional Method. These codes are linked with the course in Banner based on what is indicated in the syllabus. If the option you want is not available for a course, contact the scheduling office and we can look into adding it.

<b>CBE</b>	Competency Based Education	<b>I</b>	Online	<b>CBE</b> should always be a <u>completely online course</u> , with no expectation that a student will need to come onto campus for course work or to demonstrate skill.
<b>HYB</b>	Hybrid (Online & Face-to-Face)	<b>Y</b>	Hybrid (online & face-to-face)	Sections with HYB schedule type <b>must</b> have 2 meeting places. The first one will be a <u>classroom</u> with meeting days and times. The second will be a building of ONLINE, with the classroom as HYBRID. If a course is mostly CBE, but students will need to come on campus at any time for the course, then it should be built as HYBRID.
<b>INS</b>	Internship	<b>NT</b>	Non-traditional	
<b>INT</b>	Internet	<b>I</b>	Online or	Use "I" for traditional online.
		<b>V</b>	Virtual/Online Synchronous	Use "V" when students are expected to participate online at specific days/times.
<b>INV</b>	Independent Study	<b>NT</b>	Non-traditional or
