Snow College offers a friendly small town community with clean air, no traffic, and plenty of conveniences just outside your apartment. And did we mention we have parking?

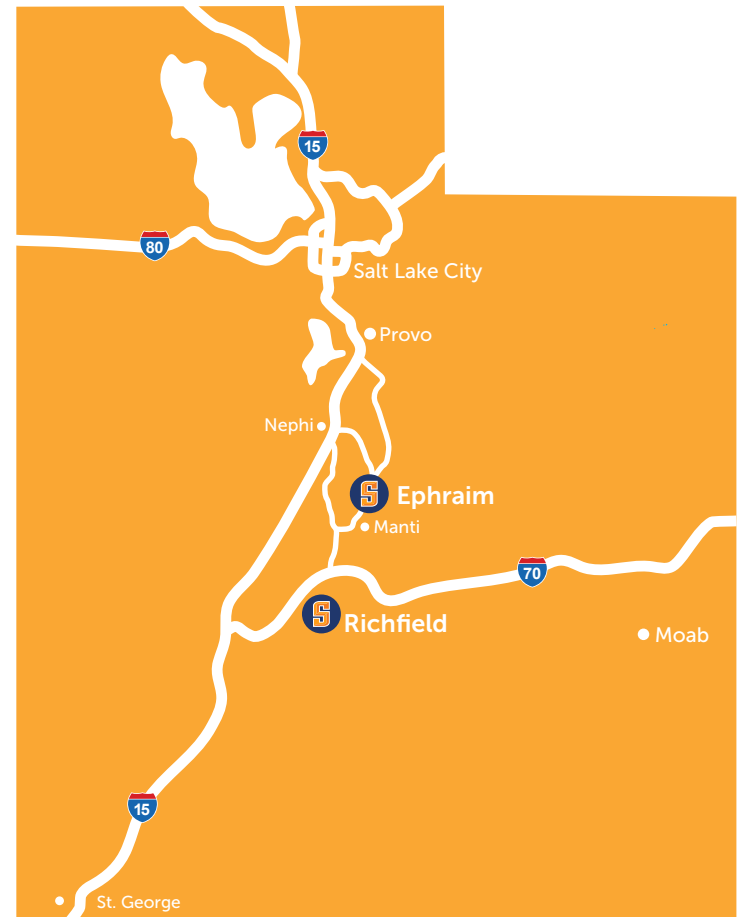

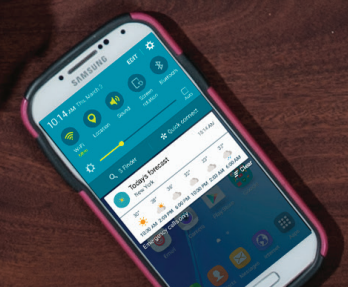

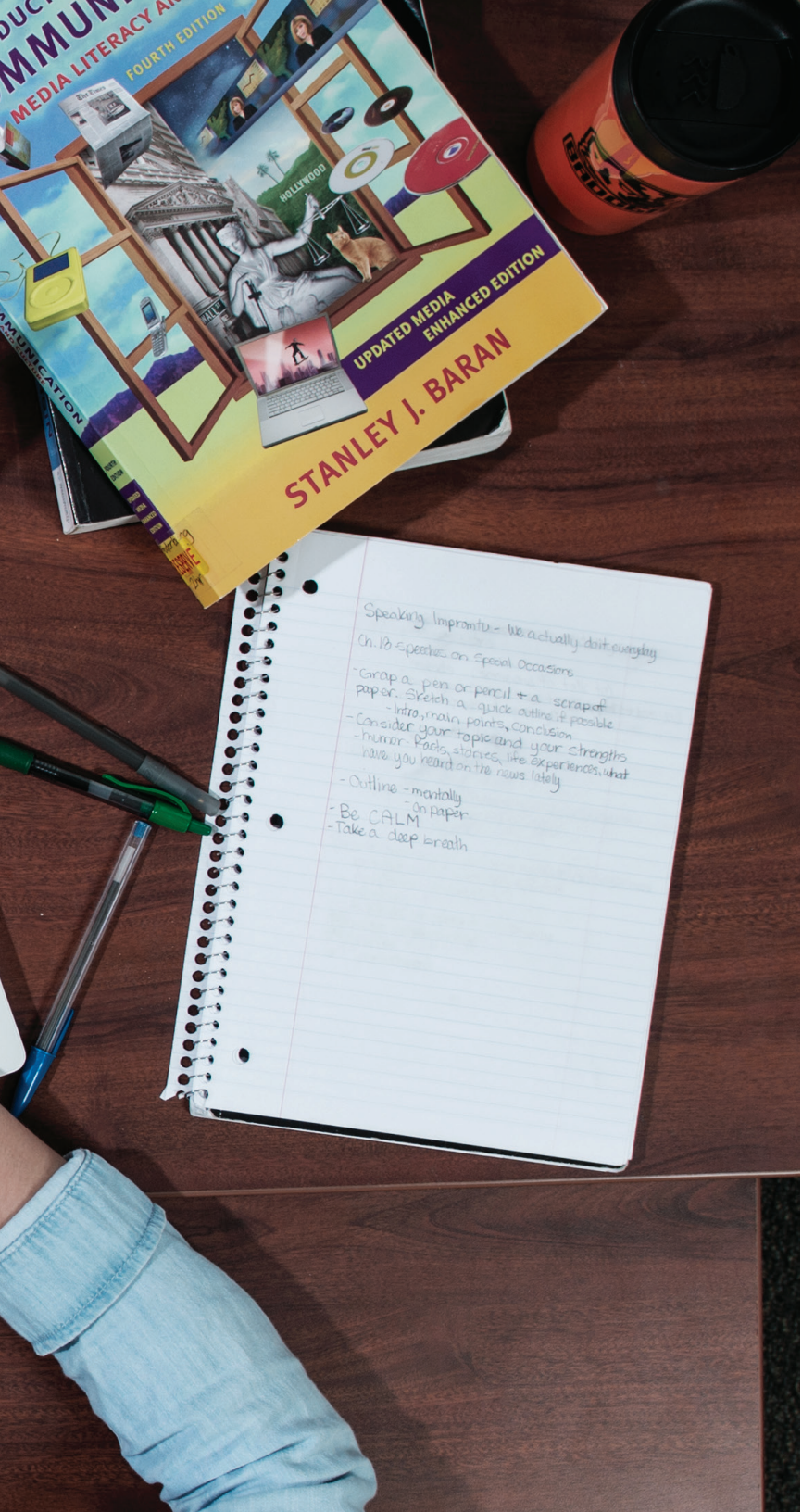

The purpose of financial aid is to assist students in paying for their education. **Ambassador Scholarships** - Looking for an opportunity to recruit as a Snow College Ambassador? Get training, make friends, and share your journey with others. An additional application and interview must be completed through the Admissions Office by March 1.

**Departmental & Talent** - Departments on both campuses have scholarship funds available! You must be majoring in specific areas to apply.

**Diversity** - Diversity scholarships for those coming from various cultural and ethnic backgrounds.

**NAW Waiver** - For students with residency in Nevada, Arizona or Wyoming. Qualifying students may be able to attend at the Utah Resident In-State Tuition cost. Please visit [www.snow.edu/scholarships](http://www.snow.edu/scholarships) for information.

**Nonresident Scholarships** - Nonresident scholarships include the Western Undergraduate Exchange (WUE) award and a Nonresident Tuition Waiver.

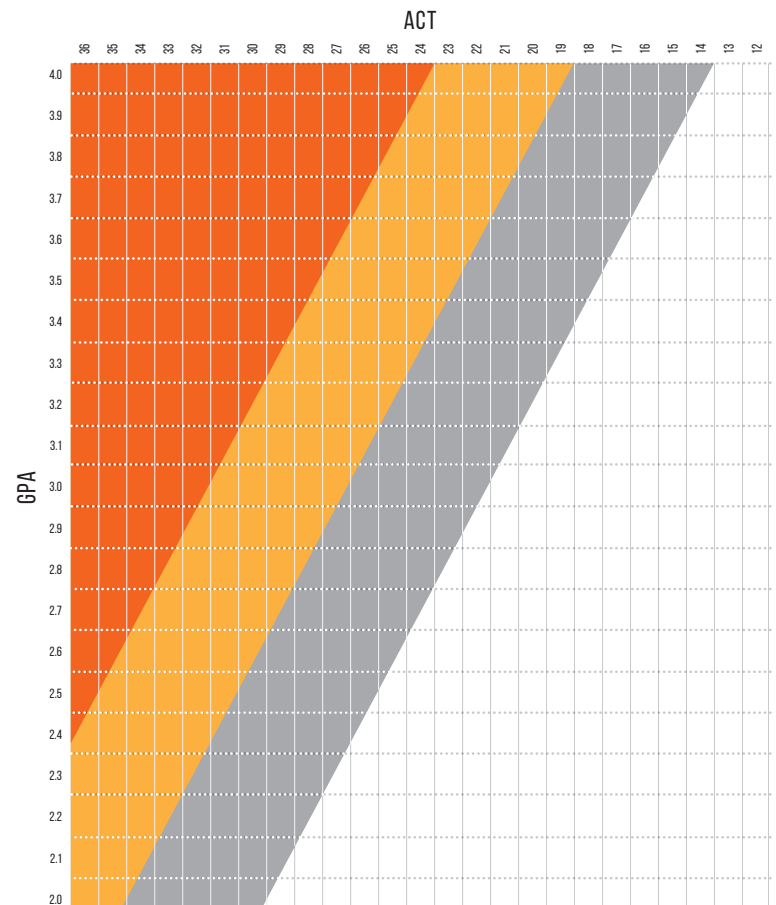

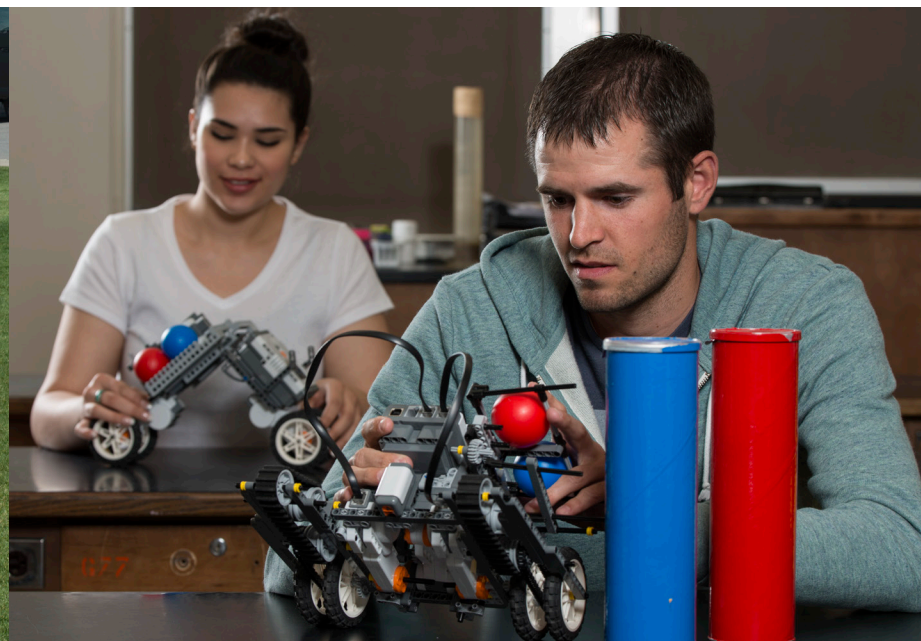

## PROFESSOR BRIAN NEWBOLD

“Good Demonstrations and Bad Jokes,” is how Brian Newbold sums up his teaching style.

While doing experimental research for NASA and the Air Force, he investigated burning aluminum dust in an acoustic field while trying to limit combustion instability in solid propellant rocket motors. So yes, he is a “rocket scientist!” He brings that experience, and his great enthusiasm for science, into the classroom.

“I enjoy teaching the variety of students that attend my classes here at Snow. Some love science, which is fun to see and encourage, but it’s great to see a student with no interest suddenly get turned on to science and what is happening in the world around them.”

Having a classroom of only 25 students is Dr. Newbold’s favorite part about Snow College, instead of the hundreds of students you see in a university classroom. He can spend time with each student and help them when they struggle. “I like that I get to teach students individually and help them succeed. That’s the greatest thing about teaching.”

“ Anyone can do science, engineering and math. Being smart doesn’t get you there; it takes hard work, and everyone can do that! ”

## NURSING

The Allied Health Program at Snow College offers courses of study in entry-level health related occupations: practical nursing, registered nursing, and nursing assistant/home health aide. Students are taught by highly qualified instructors in a small classroom setting. Courses combine classroom and clinical experience to prepare students to pass state certification exams. Entering students will be required to pass math and reading entrance tests.

Upon successful completion of these programs, students may find career opportunities in such places as hospitals, long-term care facilities, assisted living communities and with home health providers.



## COSMETOLOGY

The Cosmetology/Barbering Technology program is designed to prepare students for direct employment in cosmetology, barbering salons and/or prepare them to open new salon businesses. This program includes 1600 hours of instruction required by the State of Utah for licensure. Students are prepared to take the National Interstate Council of State Boards of Cosmetology Licensure Examination.







## AUTOMOTIVE/DIESEL

Snow College Automotive Technology Department offers an Automotive Technology program that includes the eight Automotive Service Excellence (ASE) areas. Students are encouraged to take the ASE certification tests when they complete each area. The offered areas of ASE Certification include: Auto Elec./Electronic Systems, Auto Suspension and Steering, Auto Brakes, Auto Manual Transmissions/Transaxles & Power Trains, Auto Heating and Air Conditioning, Auto Engine Repair, Auto Automatic Transmission and Transaxles, Auto Engine Performance.

Industrial Technology is one of the fastest growing career tracks in Utah. Snow College provides the tools to be part of the new industrial revolution.

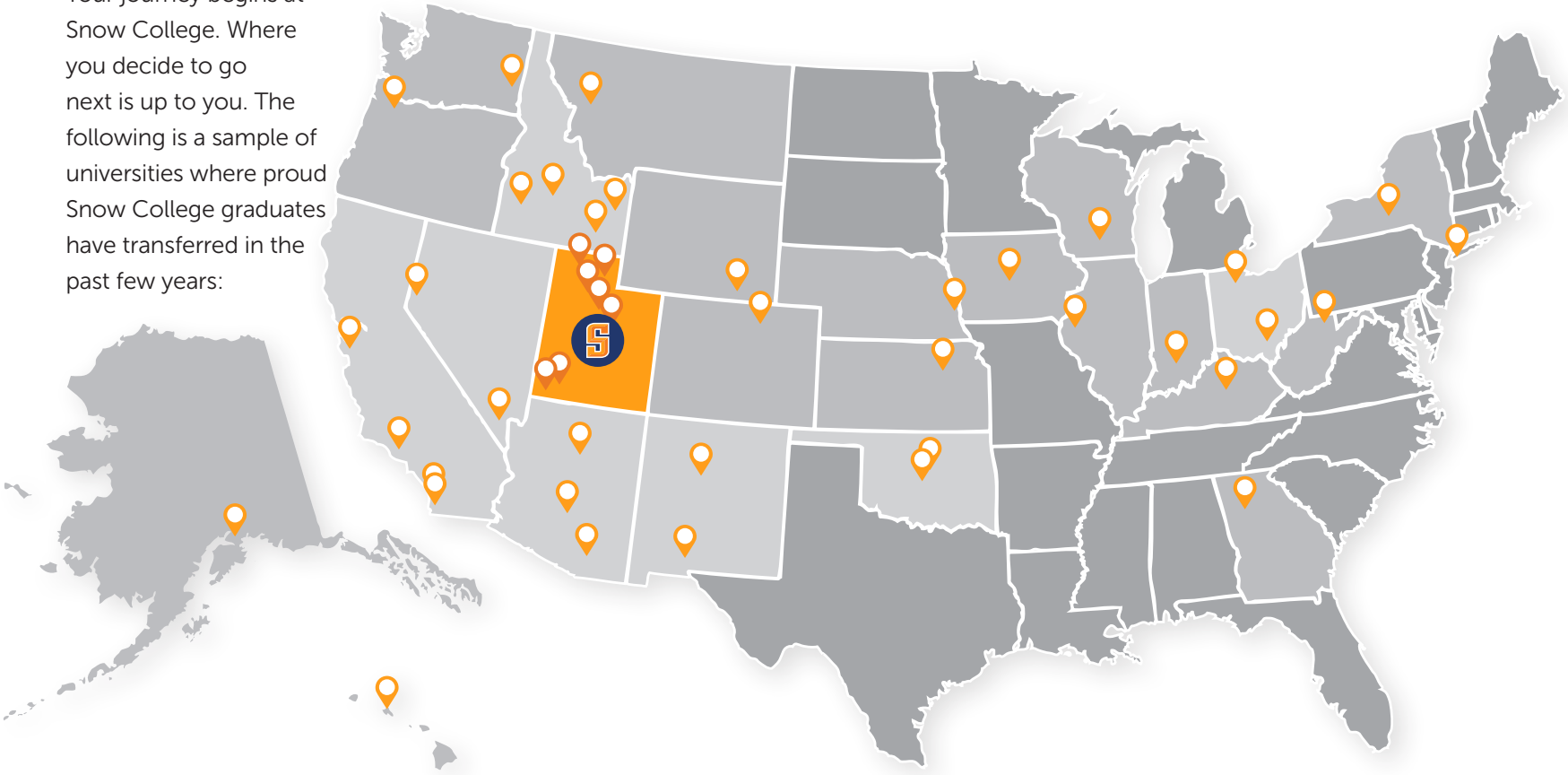
