STUDENT GALLERIES

MISSION: AltSpace and the Annex gallery are dedicated space for exhibiting independently produced work by Snow College visual art students. Submissions are juried by the art faculty. Solo and collaborative shows are encouraged.

SCHEDULE: Each gallery space is available during fall and spring semesters in two week blocks from Monday @ 8:30 am through Friday @ 5:30 pm.

RECEPTION: All participating artists are required to organize and attend their opening reception on Mondays from 12:00-1:00 pm. Refreshments are the responsibility of the artist(s).

PROMOTIONS: Students are responsible for all associated promotional material, including postcards, title cards and artists' statement.

SPACE: Each gallery will be clean and ready for installation of your show. It is the responsibility of the artist(s) to return the gallery to its original state after each show, including patching and retouching the paint and cleaning the floor.

SALES: All proceeds go directly to the artist. There is no commission taken by the Snow College Art Gallery or Snow College Visual Arts.

INSURANCE: The Artist(s) is solely responsible for all work while on exhibition.

PROPOSAL: Submit a brief written description of your intentions for the space as well as a sampling of your previous work. This proposal should be submitted on ONE SHEET OF PAPER--written proposal on top and images on the bottom.
