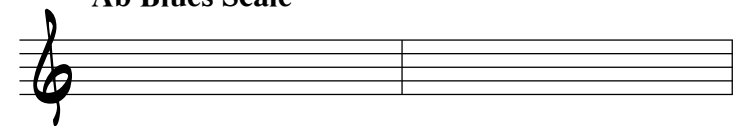
Bb Blues Scale

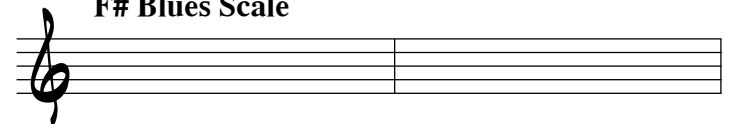
