## Honors Core Classes (6 hours)

- Honors Thesis (3 hours)

Choose one of the following

- ENGL 2014 (E2), 3 credit hours

## Other Honors Courses (6 hours)

- Elective Honors Credit (6 hours)

Choose six hours from the following

- ART 1050 (FA); 3 credits
- BIOL 1050 & 1055 (LS & Lab); 3 + 1 = 4
- COMM 1020 (OC), 3 credits
- HONR 285\_, (GE credit and hours vary)
- POLS 1100 (AI), 3 credits
- Other classes listed with a HO1 section number.

## Substitutions
