## Honors Qualifications

## Honors Requirements

The USU Honors Program requires 27 honors credits. The first 12 credits are lower-division classes and lead toward the Honors in University Studies recognition. Snow College students who have completed the honors program with their A.S. or A.A. degree will have the first 12 honors credits at USU waived.

The remaining 15 honors credits come from upper-division coursework and lead toward the Departmental Honors recognition. These credits come from courses in the student's major, and students use honors contracts, working closely with their professors, to propose honors projects.

Students who complete the honors program at Snow College and Departmental Honors at USU, can graduate with the University Honors distinction. Students who complete some honors classes at Snow but who do not complete the program should contact the USU honors director to create an academic plan.
