Snow College in partnership with **USU** offers an opportunity for students to complete a Bachelor's Degree in family, consumer, and human development studies *without* leaving the central Utah area.

Complete your Associate's Degree at **Snow College** including General Education courses and some of the required Family, Consumer, and Human Development prerequisite courses and then transfer to **USU's** branch campuses in Ephraim or Richfield to complete the rest of your upper level family, consumer, and human development studies degree requirements. Courses are delivered via an online or web-based program so students meet online at designated times.

If you have credits to transfer to **Snow College**, you are a Snow College graduate, or you are ready to graduate from Snow College, please call the Registrar's Office at (435) 283-7171, 7172, or 7176. They can assist you by sending an Official Transcript to **USU**. If you have credits from another college or university, please contact the institution where the credits were earned and request an official transcript to be sent to **USU** to help you begin your education towards a Bachelor's Degree.
