**Snow College** in partnership with **USU** offers an opportunity for students to complete a Bachelor's Degree in psychology *without* leaving the central Utah area.

Complete your Associate's Degree at **Snow College** including General Education courses and some of the required Psychology prerequisite courses and then transfer to **USU's** branch campuses in Ephraim or Richfield to complete the rest of your upper level psychology degree requirements. Courses are delivered via video conferencing technology and online.

If you have credits to transfer to **Snow College**, you are a Snow College graduate, or you are ready to graduate from Snow College, please call the Registrar's Office at (435) 283-7171, 7172, or 7176. They can assist you by sending an Official Transcript to **USU**. If you have credits from another college or university, please contact the institution where the credits were earned and request an official transcript to be sent to **USU** to help you begin your education towards a Bachelor's Degree.
