



Beyond Snow: Bachelor of Social Work, B.S.W.

Snow College in partnership with **University of Utah** offers an opportunity for students to complete a Bachelor's Degree in Social Work *without* leaving the central Utah area.

Complete your Associate's Degree at **Snow College** including General Education courses and some of the required Social Work prerequisite courses and then transfer to the **U's** program in Ephraim or Richfield to complete the rest of your upper level social work degree requirements. Courses are delivered via traditional classroom instruction, online, and video conferencing technology.

If you have credits to transfer to **Snow College**, you are a Snow College graduate, or you are ready to graduate from Snow College, please call the Registrar's Office at (435) 283-7171, 7172, or 7176. They can assist you by sending an Official Transcript to **U of U**. If you have credits from another college or university, please contact the institution where the credits were earned and request an official transcript to be sent to **U of U** to help you begin your education towards a Bachelor's Degree.
