



## Beyond Snow: Bachelor of Integrated Studies (BIS)

**Snow College** in partnership with **Weber State University** offers an opportunity for students to complete a Bachelor's Degree in Integrated Studies without leaving Central Utah.

Complete your Associate's Degree at **Snow College** including all General Education coursework; then, transfer to **Weber State** to complete the rest of your upper division baccalaureate requirements. Courses are delivered via on-line instruction with face-to-face mentoring and advisement. Weber State's BIS program advisement begins Spring 2013 with classes available Fall 2013.

Integrated Studies offers opportunity to personalize one's university education by selecting three areas of academic interest, completing pre-determined coursework in selected academic areas, and then synthesizing learned knowledge into a Capstone Project. Service and/or business related projects may include internship experiences in the Central Utah region. Some of the academic areas offered by **Weber State** on-line include: Sales and Service Technology, Health Services Technology, Health Promotion, Life-Span Nutrition, Computer Science, Health Sciences, and Child and Family Studies.

If you have credits to transfer to **Snow College**, you are a Snow College graduate, or you are ready to graduate from Snow College, please call the Registrar's Office at (435) 283-7171, 7172, or 7176. They can assist you by sending an Official Transcript to **WSU**. If you have credits from another college or university, please contact the institution where the credits were earned and request an official transcript to be sent to **WSU** to help you begin your education towards a Bachelor's Degree in Integrated Studies.
