The Home Page is the first page of the Student Edition. To begin the course, or to continue working from the latest location, click the Start button in the lower right corner **6**.

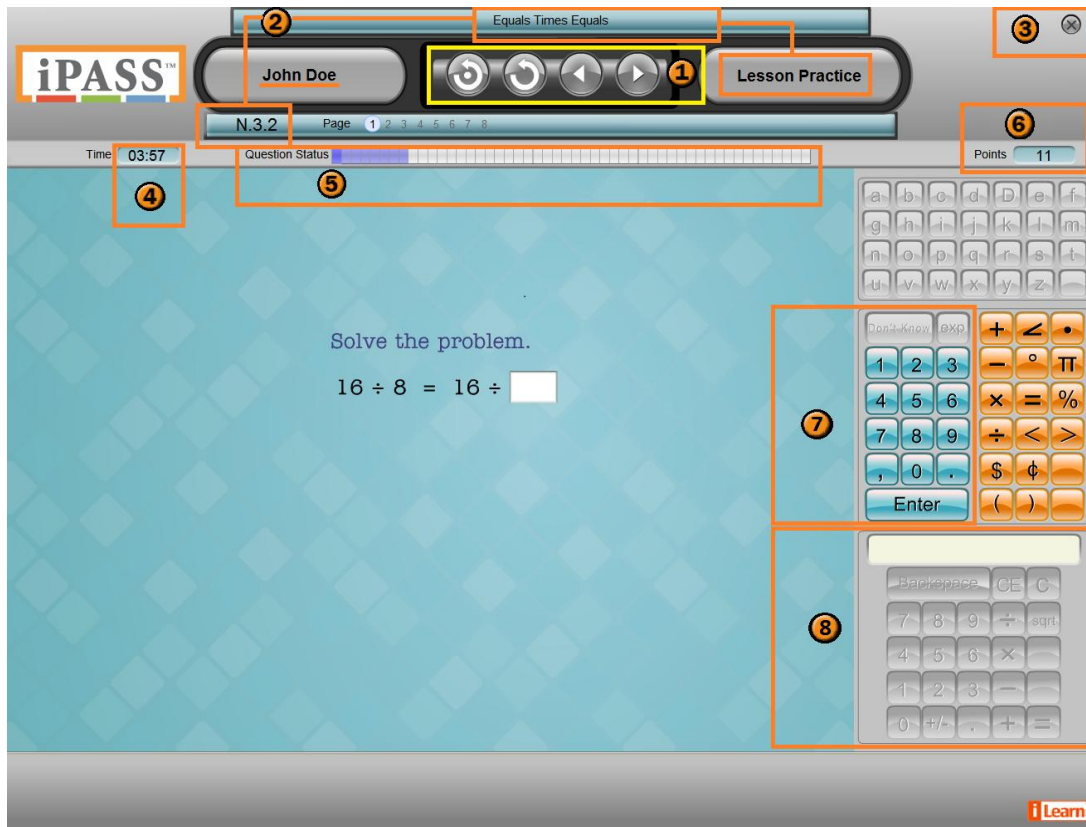

1. **Table of Contents:** links to the course outline, and it opens in a separate window as a PDF.
2. **Keypad Location:** choose what side the calculator and keypad is on when using iLearn Math by clicking .
3. **Reports:** directs to [www.ilearn.com/reports](http://www.ilearn.com/reports) to view a summary of your iLearn Math progress.
4. **Normal Mode:** is automatically active, which means the order of lessons is selected by the program.
5. **Review Mode:** review, in any order, elements of the program completed or exempted in Normal Mode.
6. **Start Button:** initiates the instructional program.
7. **Test Review:** each line displays a completed test with scores, passing criterion, and completion date.

### Program Interface



1. **Control buttons** (active in Lesson Instruction):
  - a. repeat the page
  - b. repeat the step
2. **Location Information:** Unit, Chapter, and Lesson are located below the user's name. The title and section is displayed above and to the right of the control buttons.
3. **Exit:** to exit the program click the "x" in the top, right hand corner.
4. **Time:** each section of the program has a time limit.
5. **Question Status Bar:** shows the required number of answers to complete the section. In Lessons, each bar is highlighted green for a correct answer. In Tests, each bar turns blue when an answer is entered.
6. **Points:** each correct answer earns one point.
7. **Answer Key Pad:** use the key pad on screen or your keyboard to enter answers.
8. **Calculator:** made available only for specific lessons.

The pointing hand  and steps  prompt users to proceed by clicking when ready.

The **blue** background indicates a lesson or practice section.

A **green** background is used for tests.

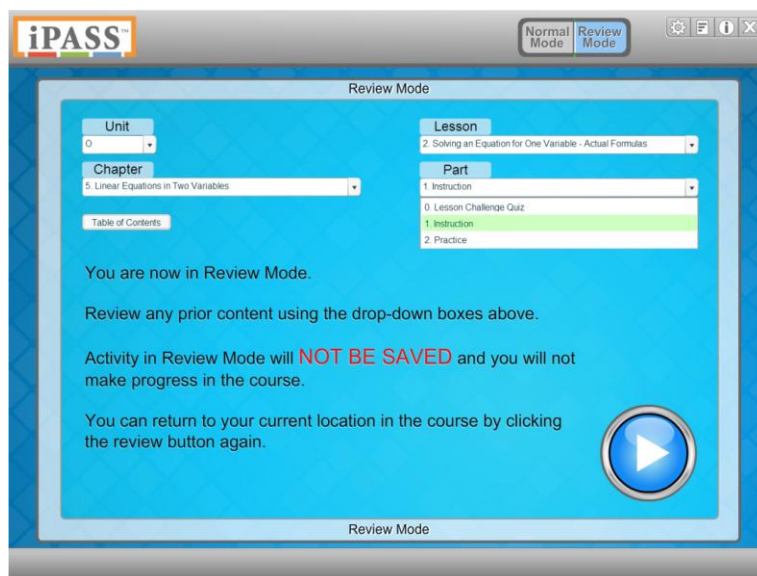

### Review Mode


Review Mode allows a student to review elements of the course in any order, but only the elements preceding the student's current location. In Normal Mode, the course is automatically presented and the student cannot select lessons.


#### Select a Location


- Use the drop down boxes to select the Unit, Chapter, Lesson, and Part. Reminder: The Table of Contents outlines each Unit, Chapter and Lesson.
- Click the Start button.
- Note: make a selection in each available drop down menu before clicking Start. Otherwise the program will return to the last viewed location.

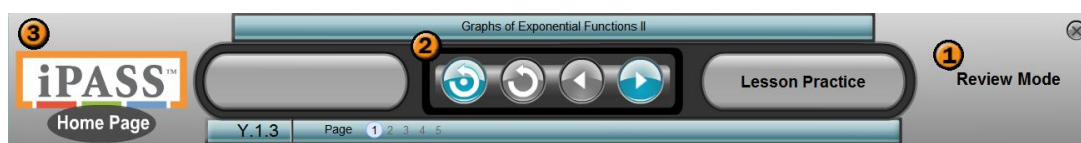


#### Navigating Review Mode

In the top right corner, "Review Mode"  is shown to indicate that you are not in normal mode and progress here will not be recorded.

To move forward through any part of the Lesson, click in the blue area when the cursor changes to a pointing finger or steps, or use the navigation buttons at the top of the screen. The navigation buttons , from left to right, are repeat page, repeat step, previous page, and next page.

After selecting a lesson or test you can return to the Review Mode Home Page at any time by clicking the upper left corner of the screen .



### Test Review

Test Review stores all completed tests with scores, passing criterion, and completion date.

- Each line represents a test.
- Click a line to open a record of your answers for that test.

#### Viewing Completed Tests
