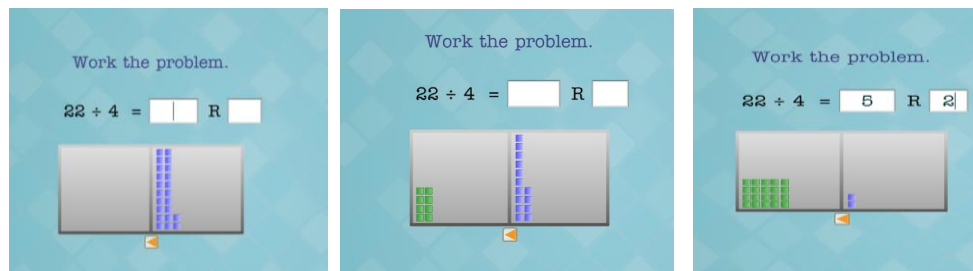

Helpful Hints

1. Use your non-graphing calculator
2. If you use your calculator, all you need to do is put the answers in the boxes. The remainder goes in the R (box)
3. When your screen looks like the box below, the computer wants you to use the orange arrow at the bottom of the gray box and move the row of blocks over to the other side. This is how they teach you to divide. Each row you move, adds to the whole number in your answer. In the example, each time you click the arrow, you move a group of 4 blocks. This indicates how many times the 4 goes into 22 evenly.



The number of rows that you move over is the whole number and the few blocks remaining is the "R" remainder.

Remember to press "enter" when done and then again for the next question.

If there is no remainder then put a 0 in the "R" box.
