



Service Learning Course Development Grant

Purpose: The Civic Engagement & Service Learning Course Development Grant is designed to aid interested faculty in developing a civic engagement or service learning component in an existing course. The grant includes a stipend of up to \$300 and the help of a colleague who is already using service learning. Grant recipients will have their course designated as a service learning class.

The above application also details the requirements for a course to receive service learning designation. In order to be considered for development grant funding, applications are due by **November 1**, and should be given to Mitch Jenks or to your division's representative on the service learning committee.

Criteria for consideration include:

- Depth & significance of the engagement or service for the chosen community
- Relevance of the community engagement or service to the course curriculum
- Work and preparation involved in developing and teaching the course
