

POTENTIAL COSMETOLOGY STUDENT

We appreciate your interest in the Cosmetology program at Snow College located in Richfield, and Kanab. New students are generally accepted into the programs, three times each year, January, June and August. Due to the high demand for this program, you are required to submit the following application information, listed below, to the registration office before you will be considered as an applicant for the program. Interested persons must submit a <u>complete</u> application and an interview process to be accepted into any of the Service Technology programs. Submission of this application does not mean you are accepted into the program. Upon completion of this information, your packet will be placed on file for review and an interview time will be scheduled as openings become available.

Please mail or deliver to the registration office the following information:

- Information form with the student's, parent's and a high school counselor's signatures are required for high school students.
- ➤ 2 Letters of Recommendation (not from family)
- Letter of intent...introduce yourself, include your goals and why you are interested in cosmetology.
- ➤ High school transcript, copy of high school diploma or GED, or explanation why it is not included.
- ➤ <u>High school students must include a letter from their high school counselor, indicating they meet requirements to attend as a full-time student their first semester.</u>

The cosmetology applications will be due in the registration office according to the following schedule:

Fall Semester Application deadline: May 1
Spring Semester Application deadline: October 1
Summer Semester Application deadline: April 1

Information for you to consider as you apply to the cosmetology program:

To become a licensed Cosmetologist/Barber, you will be required to complete 1600 hours and the licensure process through the Division of Professional Licensing.

Depending on attendance, this can be achieved in approximately 3 semesters, with an additional semester, if you choose to earn an A.A.S. degree in Salon Business.

College Students

- Summer hours: 7:45 4:45 Monday through Thursday.
- Fall and Spring semester school year hours: 7:45 4:45 Monday through Thursday 7:45-11:45 Friday
- Completed Snow College application and acceptance to Snow College.
- Tuition plus student fees (See current tuition table)
- Tuition must be paid in full or payment arrangements made in the Richfield cashiers office (\$25 fee) at the beginning of each semester or you will be dropped from classes.
- Additional costs: cosmetology, mini-nail, barber kits, trolley, smock and books; approx.\$1350
- Financial Aid available (contact the Snow Student success office for financial aid info.) be sure to file early, it takes several weeks to process.

High School Students

- Summer hours: 7:45-4:45 Monday through Thursday
- Regular school year hours: 7:45 4:45 Monday through Thursday 7:45-11:45 Friday (<u>must be able to follow this schedule for your first semester</u>)
- Schedule may be flexible after completion of first semester but must attend theory every day. 7:45-9:00
- You need enough high school graduation requirements completed to be released from your high school classes. You will need a 4-hour block for the AM classes or a 4-hour block for the PM classes with an additional 1-hour block in the morning for theory. (this applies after completing first semester)
- Completed high school enrollment form
- Letter of Permission form signed by parent and high school counselor
- <u>College credit</u> is available for high school students. Application and acceptance into Snow College is needed for acceptance into any of the Service Technology programs.
- Additional costs: cosmetology, mini-nail, barber kits, trolley, smock and books; approx.\$1350

^{*}Attention all students if absent more than 3 days, during the first semester, you may be dropped from the program and/or need to retake all of the basic courses.

Potential Cosmetology Student Application Form
