



Scholarship Program Contribution Hours Options

1. Alumni Association Events:

- a. Assist with the planning, setup, and staffing of alumni association events such as homecoming, reunions, meetings, fundraising events, and networking mixers. Where possible, scholarship recipients are encouraged to take on leadership roles in planning and executing these events, which can help develop organizational and leadership skills.
- b. Help manage communication and outreach efforts to alumni.
- c. Work with the Alumni Council to help develop and support their initiatives, such as facilitating mentorships between current students and alumni.

2. Social Media Campaigns:

- a. Serve as Social Media Ambassadors: Scholarship recipients designated as social media ambassadors for the alumni association can share their experiences, achievements, and updates about the association's activities on platforms like Instagram, Facebook, and LinkedIn.
- b. Content Creation: Under the direction of the Alumni Association, recipients to create and post a certain number of social media updates, blogs, or videos each semester that highlight their journey, the benefits of the scholarship, and the activities of the alumni association.

3. Public Appearances and Outreach:

- a. Speaking Engagements: Recipients may participate in speaking engagements at schools, community centers, or alumni events to share their stories and inspire others.
- b. Workshops and Panels: Encourage them to lead or participate in workshops and panel discussions related to their field of study or personal development.

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- a. Peer Mentoring: Assist with alumni mentorship program(s) where scholarship recipients mentor new students or other scholarship applicants, fostering a sense of community and giving recipients a chance to give back.
- b. Alumni Mentoring: Pair recipients with alumni mentors who can provide guidance and support throughout their academic and professional journeys.

5. Community Service and Engagement:

- a. Service Projects: Recipients can complete community service hours each year, which can be tied to alumni association initiatives or independent projects.
- b. Service Learning: Recipients are encouraged to service learning opportunities, where recipients apply their academic skills to solve real-world problems in their communities.

Additional Requirements

- Regular Reporting: Weekly engagement with the Alumni Office to receive leadership training and engage in the Alumni operation per contribution hours.
- Acceptance Letter: Provide an acceptance letter upon award to the Alumni Council.
- End-of-year Report: A summary of experience at the end of the academic year. The summary can be provided either in writing or in person.
