Many of our scholarships come from generous donations to Snow College. The requirements to receive and/or keep these scholarships are set by the individual, foundation, or company making the donation. To obtain a Foundation Scholarship you must be admitted and complete the Snow College Scholarship Application. An application for Federal Financial Aid, [FAFSA](#), is also required for many of these awards

Some of these are "General Scholarships" and are available to any student meeting academic standards. The requirements to keep, length and amount of each scholarship varies. To apply for a private scholarship students must complete the online scholarship application and all supporting documentation. Students must limit their private applications to five. Only the first five that are submitted will be considered.

If you are awarded a private scholarship, you will be required to write a thank you letter to the donors ([see sample thank you letter](#)). Information will be provided to you in your scholarship contract. For a sample thank you letter either contact the Snow College Scholarship office, or click [here](#).

To be eligible for these awards, students must complete the appropriate online scholarship application. Students should apply for and indicate the fund they would like to be considered for. Students should also be sure to include information specific to each scholarship they are applying for in the essay.

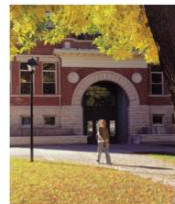

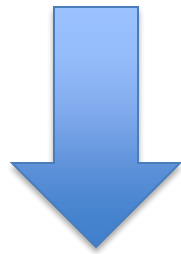

Priority will be given to students from underrepresented countries. We look for students with academic excellence, a strong history of volunteer/service experience and a desire to help others.

Our scholarships are TUITION WAIVERS and have no cash value. Students must live on-campus, perform assigned leadership functions and maintain a minimum GPA of 3.0 to maintain the award.

The deadline to apply is March 1. Applications will be reviewed based on the date submitted. Awards will be made by June 1.
