

INTERNATIONAL SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION

General Eligibility:

In order to be eligible for an International Scholarship, a student must:

1. be a full-time (at least 12 credit hours) student at Snow College
2. have completed at least one full semester at Snow College
3. be enrolled in all regular academic courses (no ESL classes)
4. have passed both the Michigan Test and the Oral Language Proficiency Interview (OLPI) with a score of at least 65 on both tests, or have met the minimum TOEFL admission requirements with the score results on file with Snow College
5. be able to demonstrate excellent academic ability, leadership, communication skills, community/campus involvement and financial need.

Applying for Scholarship:

The following documents must be received in Sharon Kilmer's office HUMAN 1711, by 4:00 PM on April 5, 2011 in order for student to be considered for the International Scholarship. No application will be reviewed unless all of these materials are present. It is up to the applicant to submit a complete file.

Please submit the following:

1. The completed application form (get one from Sharon Kilmer, HUMAN 1711 or from the holder in the hall outside the International Center office)
2. Two letters of recommendation. At least one letter must be from a professor who has instructed you in a regular academic course at Snow College.
3. A complete official copy of your transcript at Snow College
4. A personal letter explaining why you want the scholarship. You may also address demonstrated need for the scholarship.
