



Getting Started:
Admissions, Academic Advisement, Registration Checklist

1. Apply to Snow College: Complete the [Online Application](#) .
Click on “First time user account creation” if you are admitting for the first time.
If you have not obtained your Snow College (Badger) ID number, please call 435-283-7313 or go to [Badger Web](#).
2. Submit your ACT or SAT scores and high school transcript: ACT or SAT scores are required for everyone attending Snow College who is under the age of 21 and has not completed 20 or more college credits. However, students may attend Snow College regardless of the scores received. If a student’s math score is more than two years old, a student may be required to take the Accuplacer placement exam
The Accuplacer Math Placement exam can be taken at the Lucy Phillips Testing Center for \$10. Please call the testing center to set this up: 435-283-7197.
3. If students have transfer credit, official transcripts from that college need to be sent to Snow College. Snow College also requires a copy of AP credit prior to posting the results on a student’s transcript.
4. Meet with a Student Success Advisor: After completing the above steps, the preferred method for registering for classes is to meet with an advisor face-to-face to receive personalized assistance. Please call the Student Success Center to make an appointment: 435-283-7313. If you are unable to meet with a Student Success Advisor on the Snow College campus, you may receive assistance via email. Please complete the PreAdvisement Session; the email link for Advisement/Registration is located at the end of the PreAdvisement session.
5. Register for classes and pay tuition and fees: Log on to the Badger Web, click on “Students” and “registration”. Until you complete the PreAdvisement session, you will not be able to register!
6. We highly recommended that you sign up to attend Start Smart (Snow College Freshman Orientation).
