Scholarship Eligibility and Criteria

9	Financial Need Eligibility:
	Applicant must file a <u>Free Application for Federal Student Aid</u> (FAFSA).
O	Applicant Requirements:
	Be a graduating high school senior.
	Be a resident of Utah, Idaho, Iowa or Colorado and meet all in-state residency requirements for college of attendance.
	Have a 3.0+ high school GPA and maintain a 3.0+ college GPA.
	Complete the FAFSA (annually).
	Have a goal of earning a bachelor's degree within four years or an associate's degree within two years.
2	Selection Criteria:
	The Call to Action Scholarship Program is looking for students who demonstrate:
	Outstanding character and a strong work ethic.
	Leadership potential through school and community activities.
	Commitment to educational success as reflected by GPA, coursework, and major selection.
	An ability to clearly communicate both verbally and in writing.
	Scholar Expectations:
	Meet with the CTA Scholarship Advisor two-three times each semester (online or in-person).
	Meet at least one time per year with college academic advisor.
	Work or volunteer 500 hours each year, which includes paid/unpaid internships
	Major in an approved degree (see CTA Approved Majors).
	Participate in CTA scholarship events.
	Send semester grade report to CTA Scholarship Advisor.
	Maintain good academic standing and refrain from engaging in misconduct or criminal activity.
8	Scholarship Amount:
	Cost of Attendance (COA) – Student Aid Index (SAI) – other aid = Award Amount. Award Amount not to exceed \$25,000 annually.
