



FJ Management Impact Scholarship

Application Deadline: March 1st

The FJ Management scholarship was designed to help Snow College students in need. All students are encouraged to apply, however, preference will be given to students who have any personal or family ties to FJ Management. As well as students who are not receiving Federal Financial Aid. In order to maintain the scholarship award, students must hold at least 12 credits per semester, maintain a 3.0 or higher GPA, and the student would be ineligible for any additional private scholarship support from Snow College. Credit requirement exceptions will be made for certificate seeking students. Recipients will be required to sign a consent to release information to authorize FJ Management. They must also agree to release their transcript to FJM each semester.

Two scholarships worth \$8936 each, will be awarded each year. The student will be able to retain the scholarship for up to two years at Snow College with an option for two additional years at a Utah institution of their choice to earn a bachelors degree.

If awarded the scholarship, you will receive a contract via email. Your contract will include the amount of the scholarship, the requirements to keep the scholarship, and other important information that you will need to know. Please read all instructions before answering the application questions. Incomplete applications will not be considered, nor returned to the applicant. Please fill out all sections completely.
