

## FJ Management Impact Fund Application

**Application Deadline: March 1**

**This scholarship supports students studying one of the qualifying majors at Snow College.\* Preference shall be given to students who have any personal or family ties to FJ Management (FJM). Preference shall also be given to students who are not receiving full federal financial aid. Scholarship recipients will be ineligible for any additional private scholarship support at Snow College. Two scholarships (approximately \$9,000 each) shall be awarded each year. Each recipient shall retain the scholarship for two years at Snow College with an option for two additional years at a Utah institution of their choice to earn a bachelors degree. Recipients must be on track to earn an associate's degree, maintain a 3.0 GPA or higher, and be enrolled in 12 or more credits per semester to retain scholarship support. Recipients will also be required to sign a personal information disclosure agreement to be provided to FJM for management of the full four-year scholarship. Recipients must also agree to release their transcript to FJM each semester. Additional funds available in the scholarship fund will be used to support certificate-seeking students on a year-by-year basis.**
