LEADERSHIP SCHOLARSHIP PROCESS AND PROCEDURES

APPLICATION PACKET MUST BE RECEIVED and INTERVIEW COMPLETED BEFORE: **March 1, 2015**

Steps to Apply for the Ambassador Leadership Scholarships:

1. Be officially admitted to Snow College by filling out the admission application, (*available online at www.snow.edu/apply*) submitting your official high school transcript and ACT score.
2. Complete this leadership scholarship application.
3. Create a resume highlighting your previous employment, leadership and service experience.
4. Call and schedule your on-campus preliminary leadership interview at 1-800-848-3399. Interviews will be held at these 2015 Snow Blast: January 16-17th, February 6-7th and February 20-21st. If none of those dates work with your schedule we will also be hosting interviews: January 21st, February 11th and 23rd. Your interview must be completed before March 1. *Please bring your completed application and resume with your interview

During the interview, you will be required to do a three-minute presentation on **How YOU CAN MAKE A DIFFERENCE AT SNOW COLLEGE**. These are group interviews. Please call 1-800-848-3399 to schedule your interview. It is very important that you come prepared for this interview. You can use whatever means you want, but we will not be able to provide any technology for you (projector, computer, etc.)

NOTE THE FOLLOWING IMPORTANT INTERVIEW INFORMATION:

Following the conclusion of the preliminary interview, you may be called back for a final leadership weekend that will take place March 6-7th OR March 13-14th.

OUT-OF-STATE STUDENTS:

If you are an out-of-state student, you have the option of doing a three to five minute video about yourself in place of the on campus preliminary interview. If you choose this option, please send video on a DVD with your application by March 1. Please call 1-800-3399 with any questions.
