

Associate of Science (AS) - Accelerated Online Learning Program

Requirements

For students wishing to transfer to a four-year institution, the Associate of Science degree may qualify as the first two years of a bachelor's degree and can be used to satisfy general education requirements of four year institutions in the Utah System of Higher Education. Most accredited four year institutions outside the state of Utah accept the AS degree. For the Associate of Science Degree, students must complete a minimum of 60 credit hours including a minimum of 34 credits of general education, and achieve the general education learning outcomes.
