Title: Brass Chamber Music

Catalog Description:

In this course students participate in a group ensemble experience on brass instruments. This course may be repeated for credit.

Justification:

Music majors in general and performance majors in particular are required to participate in a chamber music experience. Playing in this kind of ensemble provides a focus on intonation, articulation and style that is not possible to achieve in a larger ensemble. This course will transfer as a performance credit. Most four-year institutions with music programs offer chamber music opportunities for undergraduates.

Student Learning Outcomes:

Students will play with improved intonation, articulation and style through practice and rehearsal of selected literature both individually and collectively. The ensemble will perform in concert or recital at least once per semester.

Content:

Members of the ensemble will learn and perform appropriate literature as selected by the instructor.

General Education Outcomes:

5) Apply a cultural and historical awareness to a variety of phenomena.

Students will demonstrate through performance an understanding of the stylistic features of the historical periods represented by the literature selected.

9) Respond with informed sensitivity to an artistic work or experience.

Students will demonstrate through individual reflections in their journal, the growth of their response to the musical works learned each semester.

Key Performance Indicators:

- Students will correctly perform literature selected by the instructor in at least one concert or recital (60%).
- Students will submit a journal containing individual reflections on the overall experience at the end of the semester (20%).
- Students will be in attendance at all rehearsals (20%).
