SNOW COLLEGE**

The Utah State Board of Regents invites nominations and applications for the position of President of Snow College with a campus in Ephraim, Utah, and a campus in Richfield, Utah. Ephraim is a city of approximately 5000 residents located 120 miles south of Salt Lake City, and Richfield has a population of about 7000 and is 60 miles south of Ephraim.

Snow College is a public, residential, comprehensive community college serving approximately 3300 students on its Ephraim campus and about 600 students on its Richfield campus. Snow College has a long tradition as an outstanding lower-division, liberal arts college, offering general education programs leading to Associate of Arts, Associate of Science, and Associate of Pre-Engineering Degrees. The quality of these programs enables students to transfer to four-year institutions throughout Utah and the United States. In its role as a comprehensive community college, Snow also offers a wide range of career and technical education programs leading to Associate of Applied Science Degrees and certificates of completion in a variety of occupations. Concurrent enrollment programs for selected high school students are also offered.

The President is appointed by and serves at the pleasure of the State Board of Regents and is responsible to the Regents for the overall administration of the College. Candidates must have broad administrative experience and proven educational leadership ability. An earned doctorate or equivalent terminal degree is required.
