

Snow College Agriculture continued their 30 plus year tradition of hosting the annual FFA Field Day competition for High School FFA students on October 5, 2010. After 30 plus years of organizing and hosting the FFA Field Day, Jack Anderson turned the reins over to Jay Olsen. One thousand four hundred and ninety five (1,495) high school FFA students from 67 Utah high schools were on campus for the competition.
